- The #5-ranked Ohio Northern men's soccer team (1-0-0 overall, 0-0-0 OAC) opened its 2013 season with a 3-1 victory at Franklin (Ind.) in the Franklin Classic on Sat.
- ONU's match against Rose-Hulman (Ind.) on Sat. was cancelled with the score at 0-0 in the 27th minute due to lightning.
- Per NCAA rules, when the lightning had not stopped 90 minutes after the anticipated end of the match, the match was automatically cancelled.
- Trailing 1-0 at halftime, ONU scored three second half goals to top Franklin.
- Northern tied the game at 1-1 in the 52nd

minute, when sophomore Chase Mueller (Akron/Walsh Jesuit) sent a ball into the box that senior Michael Grossnickle (Avon, Ind.) headed into the goal.

- ONU then took the lead in the 75th minute on a goal from freshman **Ryan Prescott (Dublin/ Coffman)**. Senior **Matt Fleming (Liberty Township/Lakota East)** picked up the assist on the play.

- Senior Jeremy Barnes (Columbus, Ind./ North) put the game away six minutes later, when he buried a free kick to the upper right corner of the net to make it 3-1 ONU.
- Freshman **Evan Bader (Norwalk)** picked up his first career win in goal, making two saves on the night.
- Northern will host Anderson (Ind.) on Wed. and will host Kalamazoo (Mich.) on Sat. this week.

- Sophomore **Heather Saunier (Dayton/Oakwood)** dished out 145 assists and freshman **Kristin Sessler (fremont/St. Joseph)** had a team-high 65 digs.

- The Polar Bears (2-0) finished with 31 points, Heidelberg was second with 39 points and Bluffton was third with 96 points. A team of ONU Alumni scored 76 points in the meet.
- Junior Catie Huber (Findlay) led ONU across the finish line, placing second of 52 runners in 20:18 over the 5.000-meter course.

Football Preview

Alfred St. (NY) (0-0, 0-0 USCAA) at Ohio Northern (0-0, 0-0 OAC)

Saturday, Sept. 7, 2013, 1 pm Ada War Memorial Stadium, Ada, Ohio

Series: This is the first meeting between the two schools. **ONU coach Dean Paul:** Paul in his 10th season at ONU with a 60-32 record. His is 102-42 in 14 seasons overall and is 0-0 against ASC.

ASC coach Mick Caba: Caba is in his 13th season at ASC with a 55-65 record. He is 69-85 in 16 years overall and is 0-0 against ONU.

Today's Contest: Today is the 2013 season opener for both teams. The game is being played at Ada War Memorial Stadium because new Field Turf is being installed at Dial-Roberson Stadium. Bill Robinson Field at Dial-Roberson Stadium will be dedicated on Oct. 5 when the Polar Bears host Mount Union. It is also the first-ever game for Alfred State as a full member of NCAA Division III. ASC had been playing as a member of the National Junior College Athletic Association, winning the NJCAA Division III regional title in 2011.

ONU 2013 Preview: The Ohio Northern football team is looking to rebound from a disappointing won-loss record in 2012. Northern was 1-3 in games decided in the final minute a year ago. The Polar Bears welcome back 41 lettermen, 13 starters and both kickers. Northern returns five starters on the offensive side of the ball, but have seven players with extensive starting experience. OT Michael Howell started eight games at right tackle and leads a list of three returning offensive linemen. OG Rody Seballos and OT David Ampadu each started as freshman on the left side of the line and combine with Howell to give the Polar Bears a solid nucleus up front. WR **Devon Price** had a solid freshman season as a receiver, catching 28 passes for 381 yards and two TDs. TE Sean Wolf will switch to FB. The defensive line is anchored by returning DT Mike King, DE Josh Simon and DE Adam Best. LB Dillon Kwiat returns and DE Steven Kenny will move from LB. CB Ryan Reid, CB Zach Runzo, S Josh Colbert and S Justin Tello all return. All-Conference P Kevin Weslosky returns, as

does K Luke Rice and K Matt Chaney to give ONU one of the best kicking combinations in the league

ONU Leaders: The ONU running game was led in 2012 by RB Carter Paul (154 att, 658 yards, 5 TDs) and QB Tate Humphrey (118 att, 225 yards, 4 TD). QB Tate Humphrey completed 134 of 226 passes for 1,830 yards and 18 TDs last year. WR Justin Wilson (58 rec., 657 yards, 8 TDs) and WR Devon Price (28 rec, 381 yards, 2 TDs) led the ONU receivers. LB Steven Kenny, LB Joe Powell and LB Dillon Kwiat led the ONU defense with 82, 66 and 59 tackles, respectively. DE Sean Denson led the team with 6.0 sacks.

NCC 2013 Preview: Not only will this be Alfred State's first year competing in the United States Collegiate Athletic Association football, but it's the Pioneers first year as a four-year NCAA Division III institution. With the benefit of having juniors and seniors on the team, Alfred State will be returning six players on offense and nine players of defense from 2012's 5-4 campaign. The Pioneers top returning players on offense are WR Devin Simmons and QB Greg Hampton, both returning after playing previously in 2011. During that season Simmons had 50 catches for 770 yards and 11 TD's while Hampton amassed 1600 yards and threw for 19 touchdowns. Alfred State's top returning defensive starters are LB Rory Spain, the team's leading tackler in 2011, and SS Keegan Phalen, the team's leading tackler in 2012.

ASC Leaders: The NCC running game was led in 2012 by RB Dileel Bartley (73 att., 281 yards) and RB Major Everett (36 att, 132 yards, 1 TDs). QB Joey Frendo was 96 of 194 passing for 1,233 yards and 8 TDs. WR Colto Caldwell (27 rec., 467 yards, 5 TDs) and WR Erik Simmons (27 rec., 334 yards, 1 TD) led the ASC receivers. S Alonzo Joyner, LB Michael Gibson and CB Collin Frazer led the ASC defense with 75, 69 and 50 tackles, respectively. LB Thomas Daniels led ASC with 5.5 sacks.


