Men's Cross Country

Record: 120-37 Overall

Last Week: No Team Scoring at NCAA III Great Lakes Regional at Wilmington, Sat.

Notes:

- Ohio Northern senior **Nathan Rosenbaum (Orville)** finished 152nd out of 280 runners at the NCAA Division III Men's Cross Country Championships Saturday afternoon at the Golf Center at Kings Island in Mason.
- Rosenbaum finished the 8,000-meter course in 25:36.
- "He was in the race early, but the course con-

ditions were not ideal", ONU head coach Jason Maus said. "He gave a good effort, represented us well, and really soaked up the experience." "At the start of the race I got up front the way I wanted to," Rosenbaum said. "It wasn't my best race, but that happens sometimes." "This marks the ninth consecutive season that Ohio Northern was represented at NCAA Championships in either the men's or women's race.

Wrestling

Record: 3-0 Overall, 0-0 OAC (t1st)

Notes:

- The Ohio Northern wrestling team (4-0 overall, 0-0 OAC) rallied from a 9-3 deficit to post a 21-13 wrestling dual meet victory at NCAA Division I foe Davidson (N.C.) Sunday morning at Belk Arena.
- This is the fourth consecutive season that the two schools have met in a dual meet, with ONU holding a 3-1 lead in the series.
- ONU won six of the 10 bouts in the match, including five of the last six to post the victory.
- Northern got off to a quick start as freshman **Brad Taton (Mentor/Lake Catholic)** won 6-4 at 125 pounds to out ONU up 3-0. Taton is now 4-3 on the season.
- After three consecutive Wildcat decisions made it 9-3, sophomore **Gennar Feucht (Grove City/West Jefferson)** won by decision at 157 pounds to pull the Polar Bears within 9-6 and improve his record to 11-1 on the year.

Grapplers go on road to top NCAA DI foe Davidson, 21-13

- Junior **Colt Lovejoy (Harrod/Allen East)** tied the match at 9-9 with a 6-0 decision at 165 pounds to improve to 8-1 on the season.
- Junior **Tyler Gargano (Hermitage, Pa./Hickory)** put the Polar Bears up 12-9 with a thrilling 3-2 win at 174 pounds. Gargano remains undefeated at 5-0 on the year.
- At 184 pounds, freshman **Aaron Adkins (Norton/St. Vincent-St. Mary)** used a takedown and a 3-point near fall late in the second period to take a 9-4 lead and went on to a 13-6 decision. Adkins is now 9-1 on the season.
- Leading 15-13 entering the final bout, senior All-American **Cody Lovejoy (Harrod/Allen East)** picked up his eighth pin of the season to give the Polar Bears the 21-13 victory. Lovejoy now has a 9-0 record.
- The Polar Bears will return to action Dec. 6 when they host the 34th annual ONU Invitational in the ONU Sports Center Fieldhouse.

- The Ohio Northern women's basketball team (3-1 overall, 0-0 OAC) posted a 2-0 record last week, defeating Knyon 66-46 on Wed. and Adrian (Mich.) 87-80 in overtime on Sat.
- Against Kenyon, junior **Carly Thomas (Strongsville)** had a team-high 16 points and three rebounds and senior **Jordan Kimes (Lexington/Northmor)** added 11 points for ONU.
- Northern jumped out to a quick 15-2 lead and never trailed in the contest.
- At Adrian, Kimes had her first double-double of the season with 21 points and 10 rebounds to lead Ohio Northern
- ONU had four players in double figures in scoring, led by Kimes with 21. Sophomore **Britt Lauck (Lima/Shawnee)** scored 16 points and

- Through 4 games this season, Kimes leads ONU in scoring with a 12.8 ppg average.
- Thomas is second at 11.8 ppg and Lauck is third at 8.5 ppg.
- Bullimore leads the team in rebounding at 7.3 rpg and Kimes is second at 6.5 rpg.
- The Polar Bears will host Defiance in the first game of a women's/men's double header against the Yellow Jackets on Tue.
