Women's Swimming & Diving

Record: 2-6 Overall, 2-1 OAC (t3rd) Last Week: 7th of 10, with 832.5 Pts. at Wooster In Idualian, Thu.-Sat.

This Week: Idle.

Notes:

- The Ohio Northern women's swimming & diving team (2-6 overall, 2-1 OAC) finished 7th of 10 teams with 832.5 points at the Wooster Invitational Thu.-Sat. at Wooster High School.
- The Polar Bears set 4 school records and surpassed 3 NCAA "B" Cuts in the meet.
- Junior Jill Chapman (Sandusky/Perkins) set four school records, including a 27-year old record in the 100 free, to lead the Polar Bears.
- She also surpassed the NCAA "B" Cut in two events.
- Chapman finished third in the 100 free in a school record: 52.27, breaking the previous mark of: 52.40 set by Nancy Emerick in 1988.
- Chapman won the 50 free in :23.22, setting a Wooster Invitational meet record and the ONU school record in the process.
- She also surpassed the NCAA "B" Cut of

Chapman sets 4 school records to lead ONU at Wooster Inv.

- :23.89, is ranked No. 3 nationally in the event and is less than one half second off the NCAA "A" Cut of :22.89.
- Her time shatters the previous record of :24.08 set in 2009 by Alison Garbash.
- Chapman began the meet by swimming the anchor leg of the 200 free relay team, which finished second in a school record 1:35.89.
- That time is .21 of a second better than the NCAA "B" Cut of 1:36.10
- Sophomore Emily Uhrin (Greensburg, Pa./ Central Catholic), junior Allison Lohnes (Springfield/Catholic Central) and freshman Sydney Veon (Riverside, Ill./Brookfield) joined Champan in the record-setting performance.
- Junior Lindsey Inkrott (Pickerington/Central), Veon, Lohnes and Chapman won the 200-yard medley relay in a school record 1:46.71 to lead ONU. That time just missed the NCAA "B" Cut time of 1:46.60.

Record: 4-0 Overall, 0-0 OAC (t1st) National Rank: #19 (NWCA)

Last Week: 7th of 15 with 88 Pts. H w/ONU Invitational, Sat.

This Week: H v Manchester (Ind.), Thu. Notes:

- The #19-ranked Ohio Northern wrestling team (4-0 overall, 0-0 OAC) finished seventh of 15 teams at the 34th Annual ONU Invitational tournament Saturday at the ONU Sports Center.
- Seven Polar Bears placed in their respective weight classes, led by senior All-American Cody Lovejoy (Harrod/Allen East).
- Ranked No. 4 nationally in NCAA Division III in the heavyweight weight class, the third-seeded Lovejoy defeated top-seeded and No. 7-ranked (NCAA Division II) Garrett Gray of Tiffin 8-5 in the finals.
- Lovejoy went 5-0 on the day and is now 14-0 with a team-high 11 pins on the year.
- He also topped No. 3-ranked Mackenzie Green of Trine (Ind.) 8-4 in the semifinals.
- Junior Colt Lovejoy (Harrod/Allen East), who is ranked 18th nationally by D3Wrestle. com and was seeded fourth in the tournament, posted a 5-2 record and placed fourth at 165

pounds. Both of his losses came to fifth-seeded and #12-ranked Nolan Barger of Lycoming (Pa.)

- Lovejoy improves to 13-3 on the season.
- Junior **Tyler Gargano** (Hermitage, Pa/Hickory), who was seeded sixth in the tournament and is ranked No. 16 nationally at 174 pounds, placed fourth with a 4-2 record and improves to 9-2 on the season.
- Also at 174 pounds, freshman **Alex Bair (Centerville)** went 5-2 and placed fifth in his weight class. Bair improves to 7-6 on the season.
- Freshman **Evan Morgan (Cincinnati/Elder)** placed sixth at 149 pounds with a 3-3 mark with one pin. Morgan improves to 10-7 on the campaign.
- Freshman **Brad Taton (Mentor/Lake Catholic)** placed seventh at 125 pounds with a 3-2 record. He is now 7-5 on the season.
- Junior **Greg Biben (Aurora)** placed seventh at heavyweight. He posted a 3-2 record and is now 5-4 on the season.
- The Polar Bears will host Manchester (Ind.)

- The Ohio Northern men's basketball team (5-1 Overall, 1-1 OAC) opened its OAC slate with a 78-67 win over Otterbein on Wed. and a 77-70 loss at Mt. Union on Sat. last week.
- Senior **Lucas Pennington** (**Lyons/Evergreen**) nailed five 3-pointers and scored 19 points to lead Ohio Northern past Otterbein.
- Sophomore Konnor Baker (Ada) added 17 points and five rebounds for the Polar Bears, while sophomore Alex Radkiewicz (Powell/Olentangy Liberty) added 14 points and five boards.
- At Mount Union, Pennington hit five 3-pointers and scored a game-high

17 points and Baker added a spark off the bench, scoring 12 points and grabbing three rebounds.

- Through 6 games this season, Baker leads ONU in scoring with a 15.3 ppg average.

- Against JCU, ONU rallied from a 56-46 deficit with just more than eight miniutes to go to post the win.
- Senior **Jordan Kimes** (**Lexington/Northmor**) led all scores in the game with 18 and pulled down a team-high nine rebounds.
- Sophomore **Brooke Espenschied (Hilliard/Bradley)** added 15 points and a game-high three steals.
- At Otterbein, freshman **Amy Bullimore** (**Morrow/Little Miami**) came off the bench to score a game-high 17 points to lead ONU.

- Bullimore posted her second career double-double with $10\ \rm rebounds$ to go with her $17\ \rm points$.
- Kimes also had a double-double for ONU, scoring 15 points and grabbing a game-high 11 boards. It was her second double-double of the season and the 10th of her career.
- Junior Carly Thomas (Strongsville) added 11 points.
- Through 7 games this season, Kimes leads ONU in scoring with a 13.3 ppg average and in rebounding with a 7.7 rpg average.
- Thomas is second in scoring at 10.3 ppg and Bullimore is third at 8.7 ppg.
- Freshman **Amy Bullimore** (**Morrow/Little Miami**) is second in rebounding at 6.7 rpg and Thomas leads the team in assists with 16.
- The Polar Bears will host Ohio Wesleyan on Wed. and will play at Capital on Sat.

Record: 6-1 Overall, 3-0 OAC (1st)

Last Week: 2nd of 9, with 1198 Pts. at Wooster Invitational, Thu.-Sat. **This Week:** Idle.

Notes:

- The Ohio Northern men's swimming & diving team (6-1 overall, 3-0 OAC) finished second of nine teams with 1198 points at the Wooster Invitational Thu.-Sat. at Wooster High School.
- Freshman **Trevor Keriazes** (**Springfield**) and junior **Mitchell Murphy** (**Perry**) set individual school records and the Polar Bears as a team broke three school records and surpassed the NCAA "B" Cut seven times in the meet
- Keriazes shattered the school record in the 400 I.M. by finishing third in 4:06.92, a full 1.38 seconds better than the previous record of 4:08.30 set by sophomore **John Raker** (**Lebanon/Lakota West**) last year.
- Raker also broke his school record in the race, finishing fourth in an impressive 4:07.00.
- Both Keriazes and Raker surpassed the NCAA "B" Cut of 4:07.40 in the event.
- Keriazes also had an outstanding effort in the 200 I.M. winning the event in 1:52.74, a full .51 of a second under the NCAA "B" Cut time of 1:53.25.
- Murphy finished second in the 50 free in :20.86, but set the school record and equalled the NCAA "B" Cut in the prelims with a :20.84 effort.

Keriazes, Murphy lead strong ONU showing of 3 school records, 7 NCAA "B" Cuts

- He broke the previous school record of :20.97 set by Christian Garlock in 2013.
- Murphy combined with sophomore **Eric Chen (Mason)**, freshman **Thomas Golba (Dayton/Alter)** and sophomore **Logan Pfeifer (Bucyrus/Colonel Crawford)** to win the 200 free relay in a school-record 1:23.26.
- That time edged the previous school record of 1:24.41 set by Garlock, Marc Anderson, Drew Keriazes and Anders Samuelson in 2011 and was .04 of a second under the NCAA "B" Cut time of 1:23.30.
- Murphy joined with Dauch, Keriazes and sophomore **Jeremy Preston** (**Painesville/Harvey**) to finish third in the 400 medley relay in 3:24.41, which was nearly seven seconds under the NCAA "B" Cut standard of 3:31.35.
- Preston won the 100 fly in :50.06. He surpassed the NCAA "B" Cut with a :49.96 finish in the prelims Friday afternoon.
- The 200 medley relay team of freshman **Gabe Dauch (Norwalk/St. Paul)**, Keriazes, Preston and Pfeifer finished second in 1:34.21.
- The Polar Bears are idle through the holidays and will return to action Jan. 3 at the Citrus Classic at Mesa, Ariz.
