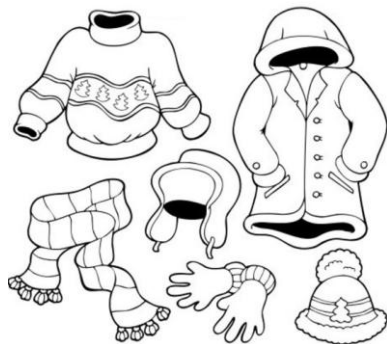
We appreciate everyone who supports ReStore. ReStore could not operate without you. **Thank you** to the crocpot volunteers, our donors and the many people who smooth our operations.
