Parade: Saturday, Sept. 18, 2021 - 10 a.m.

Line up one hour prior to parade start – rain or shine
The parade will be cancelled if lightning and thunder occur at parade's beginning
Line up at Ada school parking lot – behind school located at 725 W. North Avenue, Ada

The Ada Area Chamber of Commerce Harvest and Herb Parade Committee invites you to participate in this year's parade.

Parade guidelines:

Parade entry form needs to be submitted by Aug. 30 to the parade chairman.

The parade line up is in the parking lot behind the Ada school, 725 W. North Ave., Ada.

The parade starts at the school, goes down Main Street and ends at College Avenue.

During this day vendors will be set-up along Main Street – which makes the pathway narrower – please take this into account as you plan your entry.

All entrants must have an identifying sign or banner.

If you need a car or pickup truck, please make those arrangements, or let the parade chair know if you need assistance.

All vehicles must be on the corner of West Montford and Grand Avenue for line up at 9 a.m. (1 hour prior to the parade start). The police, VFW color guard, fire and emergency vehicles will lead the parade.

All marchers should be at Ada schools near the gym for line up at 9 a.m. (1 hour prior to parade start).

A parade assistant will be at the school to help your group get in line.

If your unit/group plans to hand out candy or other items, please have walkers do this along the side of the unit – for safety reasons.

Groups with animals must have scoopers to provide clean up along the parade route.
