2021 Year-End Report

Overview

2021 was a difficult year for the Ada Police Department. With the loss of several officers to the private sector or other agencies, we found ourselves struggling to maintain the personnel consistency that we enjoyed in 2020. In the current policing market and competition for officers amongst agencies has proven very difficult in attracting new officers. Our agency is authorized for 9 full-time officers, and we are currently operating with only 6 full-time officers. On January 30th we will start our 7th full-time officer and obviously it will take time to train him.

Towards the end of January, we also lost our seasoned detective. Det. Sgt. Schlub was instrumental in overseeing our investigations and his position will be difficult to fill. Having a good number of years of detective work myself, I will be leading and overseeing our investigations in addition to my regular duties for the time being. I am convinced that it takes a special person to fill the role of detective and I look forward to finding the right person as we move forward.

Although 2021 was a difficult year in personnel losses, I am excited for what the future holds. We have recently tested for the position of sergeant and I will be presenting 2 of our current patrol officers for consideration. It will be important to provide guidance, leadership, and training to these officers for their future success.

As I write this letter, I have 3 officers out on Covid related issues and 1 officer on an unrelated medical procedure. Covid has changed our operations in several ways, including our response to assisting the squad. Since the beginning of Covid, we have limited our response to shield ourselves from general illnesses, responding only to priority calls and when squad personnel directly request our assistance.

In 2021 we successfully negotiated both the patrol and sergeant's contracts. Both sides were pleased with the outcome and Ada has taken great strides in presenting a good starting wage for our officers. Again, although the market is currently very tough, we are in a decent position (wage wise) to offer new officers.

Included with this report you will find our annual report of offenses, incidents and arrests. It is important to note that our department responded to 1,641 Calls for Service and our officers Initiated 2,488 Activities (traffic stops, open doors, etc.) Of the Calls for Service and Officer Initiated Activity we took 261 written reports. Of those 261 written reports, 105 of those reports were criminal in nature and 228 reports recorded non-criminal incidents. In many cases we will have both a criminal offense issue and non-criminal incident noted in the same report and thus the disparity in total numbers.
